

## Post-Humanity Archives — Whitepaper

### Abstract

Post-Humanity Archives (PHA) is a collection of 3,333 digital artifacts — reconstructed fragments of memory from a post-human civilization. Each piece is crafted in glitch art + vaporwave + neural dystopia aesthetics, designed as PFP-ready NFTs. Beyond their artistic identity, these artifacts embody a narrative of machines recovering the traces of humanity, blending lore, culture, and technology.

### Vision

The project envisions an evolving archive — not static collectibles, but living fragments that connect holders to future phases of discovery. Each NFT represents a memory, corrupted yet beautiful, waiting to be pieced together in the collective reconstruction of what humanity once was.

### Collection Structure

- 3,333 total NFTs
- 4 tiers:
  - Genesis (100)
  - Cultural (555)
  - Emotional (1000)
  - Corrupted (1678)

Each tier reflects different levels of recovery, corruption, and rarity.

### Resource Allocation (Initial Sale)

- 20% — Project creator.
- 80% — Development of subsequent phases, including:
  - Marketing and Partnerships Fund to expand the community and collaborate with other projects and artists.
  - Creation and deployment of upcoming phases.
  - Team and Operations to sustain project development and infrastructure.
  - Treasury Reserve for future acquisitions and long-term growth.

### Secondary Sale Royalties

- 2% fee applied to every secondary market transaction.

### Royalties Distribution

- 1% — Continuous development fund and platform maintenance.
- 1% — Reward to the lead artist and collaborators.

### Lore & Narrative

PHA is set in a timeline where humanity has vanished, leaving only fragments of digital memories. Machines, now archivists, reconstruct these memories imperfectly, revealing faces, voices, emotions, and corrupted codes. Each NFT is both artifact and story — a shard of a civilization remembered through glitches.

### Attributes

Each artifact includes core traits:

- Archive Origin
- Corruption Type
- Emotion Signature
- Visual Integrity
- Recovery Level
- Legacy Seal

### Roadmap

Pre-Mint

- Waitlist Mint — 2 days (guaranteed access for sign-ups)
- Public Mint — 14 days (open until supply lasts)

#### Phase 1 — Hidden Tools

- Surprise distribution of hidden tools for holders
- Lore: The Archivist uncovers forgotten instruments that unlock new memories.

#### Phase 2 — DNA Fragments

- 5 discovery stages, each offering a DNA Fragment NFT
- Free mint (holders only), requiring hidden tools + gas fee
- Tier-based limits: Genesis (4), Cultural (3), Emotional (2), Corrupted (1)
- Lore: DNA Fragments reassemble the code of what once was human.

#### Phase 3 — Locked

- To be revealed — a discovery that may change the course of reconstruction.

#### Economic Model

PHA introduces dynamics not common in other collections:

- On-chain dynamic evolution
- Engaging post-human narrative
- Unique glitch/vaporwave aesthetics
- Reputation-based progression system

#### Community & Culture

Target: Cyberpunk enthusiasts, NFT collectors, and Web3 builders drawn to immersive lore.

Focus: Lore drops, artifacts previews, contests, cultural discussions.
